Announces 2026 Continuing Education Scholarships

The Askew Foundation is a non-profit Private Foundation which offers scholarships to members and associates of North Carolina Society of Enrolled Agents for continuing education courses required under Treasury Circular 230 and to aspiring enrolled agents. Scholarships are available for NCSEA continuing education events, for continuing education offered at NAEA's National Conference, and for other continuing education courses offered or sponsored by NCSEA. Scholarships are also available for the Special Enrollment Examination (SEE) prep courses offered by NCSEA or NAEA.

The SEE course scholarship application can be accessed under the same tab. Please read the applications carefully for eligibility requirements, and submit the proper application for the course you are attending. Only complete applications submitted within the proper time frame will be considered. The application must be received by 12:00 noon on the deadline date.
