Each year we honor his memory by recognizing the NCSEA member who has brought special attention to the EA credential through his professional accomplishments, the member who has diligently promoted EAs and NCSEA, or the NCSEA member who has earned special recognition for his service to the community. This year we recognize a member who has furthered NCSEA by serving wherever she is needed.**
